

Guidelines for the John J. Baglier Memorial Fund

The John J. Baglier Memorial Fund was established at The Pittsburgh Foundation to provide scholarships to seniors attending Butler Senior High school.

The following criteria will apply:

1. Attend high school at/in: *Butler High School*
2. Demonstrate financial need.
3. Participate in a cross-country and/or a track and field program at Butler Senior High School.
4. Complete an application.
5. Have a High School GPA of at least: 2.50
6. Write and submit an essay: *One page: How has your participation in cross country and/or track and field at Butler Area Senior High School affected your academic and/or personal goals?*

Final selection of the scholarship winners will be decided (subject to the approval of the Board of Directors of The Pittsburgh Foundation) by a Scholarship Advisory Committee of The Pittsburgh Foundation. The Advisory Committee consists of three to five persons from the community at large. *No member of the Advisory Committee, or his or her immediate family, is eligible for scholarship assistance during his or her tenure on the Advisory Committee.*

The Pittsburgh Foundation shall notify the chosen scholarship recipient(s) of its decision. The scholarship payment will be made annually after The Pittsburgh Foundation's June Board Meeting, and after the selected student notifies the Foundation about the school he or she will be attending. Payment will be made to the school for the student.

Each reference should address the following: (1) the applicant's general ability; (2) appraisal of the applicant, giving details in the form of examples with regard to leadership ability, citizenship, concern for others, responsibility, initiative and general interest; and (3) qualities that most commend the applicant.

GENERAL

The following items must be received in order to be eligible for a scholarship:

- This application
- Official high school transcript
- A copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) ([What is a SAR?](#))
- Essay(s)
- Letter(s) of Reference

Completed applications must be received by The Foundation no later than Inquire in the school's Guidance Office. and should be addressed as follows:
